

## Painted Rock Valentines

This is a fun Valentine's Day idea for kids to make and give! Print the cards and cut them apart. Then create painted rocks to accompany the cards. We like to use acrylic paints, and we buy nice smooth stones at Home Depot in the garden area.

The painted rocks may be a challenge to attach to the Valentine cards. Kids can hand out the cards and rocks separately, or they can package up a card and a rock in a ziplock bag. It might even work to attach the rocks with washi tape – I did not try it. I recommend printing the cards on cardstock.
