### Math Facts Tic-Tac-Toe -Parent/Teacher Page

This addition and subtraction tic-tac-toe game is perfect for kids who are memorizing their math facts! You can print the game and store it in a file folder.

There are instructions for game play on the cover page below. Attach the cover page to the front of your file folder. Then attach the game board inside the folder on the right side. Put the game pieces in a Ziploc bag and tape it to the inside of the folder on the left.

TIP: I included a full set of addition and subtraction facts, but kids will become overwhelmed with ALL the game pieces. Try using just the addition cards at first. Another option is to encourage kids to sort the cards by number first. For example, group all the math sentences that equal 6, 7, 8, etc. That is a valuable activity right there!

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

# How to Play

Lay out all the cards

Roll the dice to see what your number is for that round.

Have your opponent roll the dice to find their number.

If you roll a 1 or 2, roll again. If you roll the same number as each other, one player should roll again. Take turns playing cards that equal your number. Get three in a row to win!
